We are excited to be gearing up for the 2024 - 2025 School Year! You are receiving this package because you will be attending Coaldale Prairie Winds Secondary.

As we approach the end of this school year, more details will be determined about the 2024/2025 school year. We will communicate that to you as soon as details are finalized. For now, we want to share some information that will be helpful to you for planning purposes.

We will be having a staggered entry for students for the 2024/2025 School year.

Grades 7-9 will be starting classes on September 3rd and will obtain their schedules, lockers, text books, etc. if their fees have been paid prior to this date.

Grades 10-12 will be starting classes on September 4th and will obtain their schedules, lockers, text books, etc. if their fees have been paid prior to this date.

At Coaldale Prairie Winds Secondary School Fees must be paid before students will receive text books. School fees will be posted to School Cash Online in August.

Grade 7 - 9 School Fees will be \$99.25 (Palliser Technology Fee and Flat Option & PE Fee that cover materials used, PE field trips, etc.)

Grade 10-12 School Fees will be \$36.75 (Palliser Technology Fee)

There is also a \$5.50 Student Activity fee for all students.

Coaldale Prairie Winds Secondary does not charge locker rental fees.

Any families who are experiencing financial difficulties and as such are not able to pay school fees before classes begin are encouraged to speak with Mr. Liyesugi to discuss payment options.

SCHOOL FEES: 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR



The following fees are due before students receive text books:

Grade 7 - 9 : \$104.75 Grade 10-12: \$42.25

The Per Course fees for the first semester will be invoiced on September 19th, 2024 and then on February 20th, 2025 for the second semester.

Students who drop courses after September 30th, 2024 and February 27th, 2025, respectively, will forfeit their fee.

Any families who are experiencing financial difficulties and as such are not able to pay basic school fees before classes begin, are encouraged to speak with Mr. Uyesugi to discuss payment plans or other options. (Curtis.uyesugi @pallisersd.ab.ca)

Fees for the 2024/25 School Year will be posted to SchoolCash Online on August 20th.

Palliser Regional Schools uses SchoolCash Online for School Fees, Athletic Fees, and other program fees throughout the school year. Cash or cheque are accepted in the office if you are not able to use SchoolCash Online, however we strongly encourage online payments.
